

What: The National Overcomers Network Inaugural Event

When: October 15, 2021

Where: The Seabird in San Diego, California (and virtually in cities around the country)

Purpose of the Event

The purpose of the event is to launch the National Overcomers Network. This will be done by communicating its purpose and introducing the inaugural supporting entities and individuals to a national audience.

What is the National Overcomers Network?

The National Overcomers Network is a movement to acknowledge, amplify and equip people who have faced difficult personal vulnerabilities, and prevailed. Our goal is to build a society where overcoming is the norm, not the exception.

What does membership do?

For individuals who have overcome difficult personal vulnerabilities and are now on a mission to support systemic change within their own communities, the National Overcomers Network provides them with the platform and resources to help their message be heard. For agencies and organizations who support individuals to overcome desire to inspire and advance systemic change, the National Overcomers Network provides them with a platform and resources to help advance their objectives. This movement instills a community of belonging for anyone who has overcome and for agencies and organizations who support overcoming.

How will the National Overcomers Network be launched?

On October 15, 2021, overcomers and dignitaries will take this to a national platform. Two founding states (TN & OK) and founding overcomers from California, Washington, Louisiana, and Oklahoma will gather, collaborate, and define this movement. In the afternoon, there will be a media event featuring representatives from the inaugural states, nonprofits and overcomers, and an announcement of the key spokesperson of the network.
